Concord Imaging is excited to announce the upcoming ability to perform 3D mammography! 3D mammography, or breast tomosynthesis, is the latest technology in the fight to diagnose breast cancer as early as possible. We have purchased a brand new mammography system from Hologic called the Selenia Dimension, which combines standard 2D digital mammography with the newest technology, 3D mammography. In the same compression that the standard views are obtained in, the technologist will quickly acquire an additional set of images that can be manipulated to show very thin sections of the breast. This allows the radiologist to see the breast in very thin 1 mm slices that helps to minimize overlap of tissues. This allows the radiologist to see through the tissues better with the potential of improved cancer detection and reduced recalls. Research studies to date have shown these possibilities to be true.

We have already installed the new equipment and will be able to offer tomosynthesis to our patients and referring physicians in just a few short weeks! We expect to be performing the 3D exams by mid-November. We are thrilled to offer this new technology that we truly believe will be able to save lives.
